

Supporting your children with their education

How does it work?

IN SCHOOLS:

1/ Each school will inform you of its artistic, cultural and sporting activities and homework assistance programmes.

2/ The "Devoirs faits" homework programme is compulsory for all pupils in 6ème and enables them to make progress on their homework while encouraging their independence. *Devoirs faits* is integrated into pupils' timetables and takes place at the school under the supervision of teachers and teaching assistants.

IN ASSOCIATIONS:

3/ Educational support is organised by neighbourhood associations either on their own premises or in schools.

Whether your child is at primary school, middle school or high school, they can receive help with their working methods and take part in cultural, artistic and sporting activities. The associations in charge of educational support will be in regular contact with you and will give you the opportunity to take part in projects.

4/ Mentoring is available for your child if they are aged between 5 and 25. This enables them to develop their independence and discover training courses, professions and activities, thanks to the support of a volunteer mentor for at least one school year. Goals are set jointly by yourself, the volunteer mentor and your child. The volunteers belong to associations that train and supervise them.
